

People who have been living around these two holy sites have been the followers of these two prophets and therefore were Muslims naturally. Muslims who settled around the Ka'bah were called Arabs and Muslims who settled around Al-Aqsa were called Philistines.

According to Pro. Yigal Shiloh of The Hebrew University, two things are certain:

1. "Arab tribes inhabited Palestine centuries before Islam," and
2. The people did not lose their Palestinian component despite several foreign occupation."

Jews/Judaism or Yahood (in Arabic) can trace back their origin to the time of Prophet Musa (PBUH). After the gross misconducts and heinous actions by some Jews, Prophet Musa (PBUH) prayed to Allah:

وَأَكْتُبْ لَنَا فِي هَذِهِ الدُّنْيَا حَسَنَةً وَفِي الْآخِرَةِ إِنَّا هُدُّوا إِلَيْكَ  
Al-Araf 156.

Al-Araf 156. "Ordain for us what is good in this life and the next. Indeed, we have turned to You 'in repentance." Hudna is the verb form of Yahood, which is closely translated as Jews or Judaism.

Prophet Musa (PBUH) and his followers lived in the Red Sea region; the area is largely covered by modern day Egypt. To escape the persecution of Fir'awoon/ Phero Musa (PBUH) migrated with the 12 Jewish tribes to Philistine. The kind-hearted Muslims of Philistine provided sanctity to the fleeing Jewish people. Due to this generosity, Jewish people were able to live peacefully alongside the native Philistines. By historical count, the Jewish people were immigrant to Philistine and not the native indigenous people of Philistine. Israel came into existence in 1947/48 and Philistines have been living in the same land since time of Adam (PBUH).

### Oppressed and homeless in their home-land.

In 1947 about 14 million Muslims Philistines were living in that area. At the same time approximately 80600 (eight hundred six thousand) Jewish people were living there. Now the Israeli population is 9.55 million. Currently, the Muslim Philistine population is around Five million. Out of the five million, about three million are living in Philistine, under the naked sky as refugees, in temporary tents. The remaining two million are living as refugees in neighbouring countries. Those still in Philistine are treated as refugees in their own land.

### Now we have a very simple maths:

In 1947, Muslim Population of the entire Philistine territory was approximately 14 million and Jewish population was less than one million, approximately eight hundred thousand. Currently Israeli population is 9.55 million and Muslims Philistines population is only about three million.  $14m - 3m = 11m$ . Where is this 11 million Muslim Population of Philistine? The answer is here. Israel has been massacring the native local Philistine Muslim population since 1948.

In the 77 years that Israel has been in existence, on average each year Israel has been killing 143000/00 Philistine Muslim population. Israel has been demolishing an average of 1097 house of Philistine every year since 1947.

### Our Responsibility.

It is the individual and collective responsibility of all Muslims to safeguard Masjid al-Aqsa, its sacred precincts, Philistine Muslim population and to assist the people who are sacrificing their lives to protect this Holy site.

### Our responsibilities include but are not limited to the following:

1. Regular Dua, seek from the mercy of Allah Ta'ala and turn to sincere repentance and forgiveness. Prophet (PBUH) said: The Dua of a Muslim for his (fellow Muslim) brother in his absence is readily accepted. An angel is appointed to his side. Whenever he makes a beneficial Dua for his brother the appointed angel says, Aameen - and may you also be blessed with the same. (Sahih Muslim).
2. To create ongoing education and awareness of the crisis in Philistine and the sanctity of Masjid al-Aqsa.
3. Participate in legitimate activities that keep alive the struggle for the land of Philistine and its people.
4. Support legitimate causes for Philistine through charity and other means.
5. Vigorously engage media in the highlighting the struggle of Philistine as a humanitarian crisis.
6. Work with stakeholders, activists and governments to highlight Philistine nationally and internationally.
7. Keep the struggling of the Philistine live. The land of Philistine is the land of Prophets. Muslims are the only and natural followers of all the prophets.

## DO NOT FORGET AL-QUDS AND PHILISTINE.

He said: It was Al-Masjid al-Aqsa. I (again) said: What was the period of time (between their establishment)? He (PBUH) said: It was forty years. (Bukhari).

It is an established fact that two Muslim Prophets, Adam (PBUH) and Ibrahim (PBUH) constructed the the Ka'bah in Makkah and then Al-Aqsa in Philistine.
