

Root of all evils.

Hazrat Abu Darda (RA) stated:

"My close friend (PBUH) advised me: 'Do not drink alcohol, for it is the key to all evils.'" Ibn Majah.

Hazrat Zaid (RA) stated that I have preserved this speech from the blessed mouth of the Prophet (PBUH) in Tabuk "Alcohol is the root of all the evils". Ibn Hakim and Targheeb.

Definition of Intoxication and Alcohol.

Prophet (PBUH) said:

"Every intoxicant is unlawful, and every intoxicant is Alcohol". Nasa'i.

"Every intoxicant is unlawful and whatever causes intoxication in large amounts, a small amount of it is (also) unlawful." Ibn Majah.

"Now then O people! The revelation about the prohibition of alcoholic drinks was revealed; and alcoholic drinks are extracted from five things: Grapes, dates, honey, wheat and barley. And the alcoholic drink is that which confuses and stupefies the mind." Bukhari.

Impact of Intoxication.

Allah (SWT) called 'Intoxicant/wine/alcohol' "filth". It is filthy like urine and excrement/stool.

"They ask you about intoxicant and gambling. Say, "In both there is great sin, and some benefits for people. And their sin is greater than their benefit." Baqarah 219.

Prophet (PBUH) stated:

"Beware of wine! For its sins spread to generate other sins and overwhelm other sins, just as the grapevine overwhelms other trees." Ibn Majah.

"Whoever drinks wine in this world, he will not drink it in the Hereafter, unless he repents." Ibn Majah.

"The one who is addicted to wine is like one who worships idols." Ibn Majah.

"Whoever drinks Alcohol once, his repentance will not be accepted for 40 days, then if he repents, Allah will accept his repentance." Ibn Majah.

"Three type of people will not enter Paradise, one who is addicted to wine, one who breaks ties of relationship, and one who believes in magic." Ahmad.

"Whoever drinks wine and gets drunk, his prayer will not be accepted for forty days, and if he dies, he will enter Hell, but if he repents, Allah will accept his repentance". Ibn Majah.

"Wine is cursed from ten angles: The wine itself, the one who squeezes (the grapes etc), the one for whom it is squeezed, the one who sells it, the one who buys it, the one who carries it, the one to whom it is carried, the one who consumes its price, the one who drinks it and the one who pours it." Ibn Majah.

Hazrat Usman (RA) advised:

"Avoid Khamr/alcohol for it is the mother of all evils. There was a man among those who came before you who was a devoted worshipper and used to stay away from people." And he mentioned something similar. He said: "Avoid Khamr for, by Allah, it can never coexist with Faith, but soon one of them will expel the other." Nasa'i.

Alcohol of Jannah is waiting for You!!!

Allah (SWT) describes the provisions for the chosen servants who will be fortunate to be admitted in Jannah.

"Those are the people for whom there is a known provision. A variety of delicious fruits; and they shall enjoy honour and dignity. In gardens of pleasure. On thrones facing one another. A drink of pure wine will be passed around to them from a flowing stream. Crystal-white, delicious to drink. It will neither harm them, nor will they be intoxicated by it." As-Saffat, 45-47.

By avoiding intoxicant/alcohol/wine in this world, you protect yourself and others from the bad impact of alcohol and in return you will enjoy the pure blessed alcohol in Jannah forever.

"and their Lord will give to them to drink of a Wine Pure and Holy." Al-Insan 21.

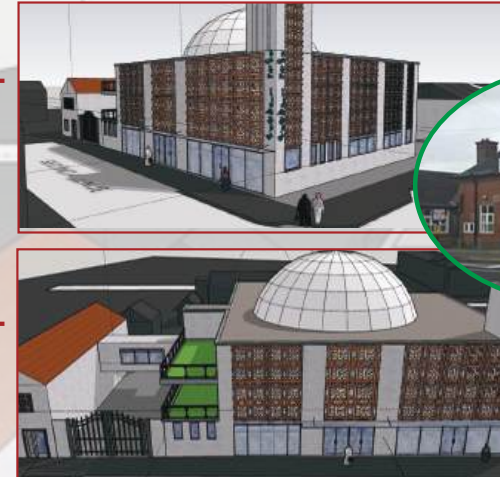
